Day riders - Pay park fees at the entrance gate to the park. We'll post as soon as we know if day riders can pay the park fee and then park at the equestrian campground.

Weekend riders - Those wanting to camp must have reservations and pay before arrival. VPHC has Equestrian Campground reserved Thursday, April 19 - Sunday, April 21.

Please RSVP to Ann at (276) 634-7619 as there may be a waiting list in case there are cancellations. **Pay for your stall(s) and campsite thru VA State Park Reservations by calling BJ at (804) 692-0544 noon to 5 pm Monday-Friday by April 4, 2018**

Equestrian Campground campsites have electric and water and cost \$20/night (\$35 non-VA resident). All have 1 time \$5 transaction fee. Stalls are \$9/night. Shavings are on site, but you may want to bring an extra bag in case. Stalls have hay nets and water buckets.

Potluck meal will follow Saturday ride around 4pm!

Please bring main dish, side dish, or dessert to share, along with your own drinks. Pit toilets only. There is a common campfire area with 3 picnic tables and a fire-ring at each end of the campground.

From I-81 near Roanoke: Take Rt 581 to Rt 220 South to Bassett to Rt 57A West to Rt 346 North (Fairystone Lake Dr)

From Richmond: Take Rt 360 West to Rt 58 West to Rt 220 North Bypass at Martinsville to Rt 57A West to Rt 346 North (Fairystone Lake Dr)

***** Caution ***** GPS may route you over some very curvy steep roads.
Recommend you come through Martinsville and follow Rt 57 to the park.
